# RED WINE

## THE AMARONE STORY

Amarone is a very special type of red wine produced in the Valpolicella area of Veneto in northeastern Italy. Think Verona and Romeo & Juliet and you are there! While there are diverse kinds of Amarone, it is generally a very dry, fresh, full-bodied wine with lots of extract, high alcohol (15-16%), and great depth and flavor concentration. Such wines date back to the Middle Ages, when ancient Greek winemaking techniques were adopted in the Venetian hinterland. *Amarone* wines were originally seen as mistakes that resulted when the Recioto wines produced via such techniques were fermented for too long and thus lost their sweetness. Hence the word Amarone comes from the Italian word *amaro* (“bitter”). It is completed by the -one suffix, which denotes impressive size or volume.

Technically Amarone is a variety of Valpolicella wine. The indigenous grape varieties from the region are a key factor to Amarone’s uniqueness. Corvina (known as “the Queen of the local grapes”) is the main player, providing backbone, structure, body and acidity. Other indigenous varieties such as Corvinone, Rondinella, Molinara and the lesser-known Oseleta are all important ingredients in the final mix, each adding its own special flavor and dimension to the wines.

Amarone is made by harvesting grapes that are then dried (or dehydrated) before fermentation. Traditionally the grapes were dried on wooden racks at ambient temperatures. Today many producers use special temperature and humidity-controlled rooms for this process to ensure that mold does not attack the grapes. This drying process lasts between three and four months, and is critical to the unique character of Amarone. As the grapes shrivel, sugars, acids, tannins, flavors, extract and other grape compounds concentrate. Additionally various reactions occur within the grapes themselves, creating more complexity. Once dried the grapes are crushed and fermented.

Most wines undergo an extended maceration of the skins, to ensure all of the complexity and goodness from the shriveled skins ends up in the wine. Then the wine is matured in oak for at least two years for ‘normale’ Amarone and not less than four years for Riserva. Grappa’s prides itself on having probably the largest selection of this spectacular wine of any establishment in Hong Kong. Our vintages range back to 1995 and our range of producers include the best of the best: Aldegheri, Allegrini, Bertani, Dal Forno, Bussola, I-Campi and the ever iconic Quintarelli.
